

State Emergency Communications Committee

Charter

The State Emergency Communications Committee (SECC) is chartered by the Nebraska Public Safety Communications Council (NPSCC) to produce and maintain the Emergency Alert System (EAS) Operational Plan of the State of Nebraska. The SECC maintains open communications between alert originators, broadcasters and cable in the event of an emergency and operates according to the Federal Communications Commission (Title 47, Part 11). The Nebraska SECC includes representatives from the National Weather Service, Nebraska Emergency Management Agency, Nebraska State Patrol, Local Emergency Management, the Nebraska Broadcasters Association, the Nebraska Cable Communications, Association, and Radio, Television, Cable Systems in Nebraska. The SECC is chaired by an individual elected by its membership on a biannual basis.

The SECC will submit an annual written report of its activities to NPSCC and verbal and written updates at NPSCC meetings.
